Proposal Objectives and Goals

Plant **200 trees** of several varieties such as:

- Eucalyptus, Cyprus, alnus
- Loblolly Pine (Pinus taeda)
- Bald cypress (Taxodium distichum)
- Staghorn sumac (Rhus typhina)
- Tulip poplar (Liriodendron tulipifera)

Objectives and Goals:

Objective 1: helping to reduce greenhouse gasses and fight climate change.

- Goal 1A: make climate solution a reality through action projects that mobilize large groups from communities greatly impacted by global warming.
- Goal 1B: limiting emission and sequestering carbon through tree plantings.

Objective 2: Attracting more wildlife and increasing wildlife habit.

- Goal 2A: Increasing wildlife and protection for conserved areas.
- Goal 2B: Supply habitats and wild forage for animals impacted by deforestation.

Objective 3: improving the quality of the natural environment

- Goal 3A: Add native and compatible soil for ecosystem restoration.

- Goal 3C: Add ecological and environment value.
