Project Introduction:

These competitions will include; football, netball and bike riding and will be launched before with; tree planting and clean ups in Kasese and Kamuli Districts of Western and Eastern Uganda respectively targeting over 300 people per competition, 50 people per tree planting and 60 people per clean up for environmental conservation.

We will base on our community, primary and secondary schools chapters as source of participants. During the implementation of every activity involved, several educative speeches will be organized mainly exposing the threats of climate change and giving hope for a better future through combined efforts at grassroot level, championed by the youths.

This Project as described below, contributes to the attainment of UN SDGs; 3,11,12,13,14,15 and 17.

Proposal Objectives and Goals

- Objective 1: To engage the male and female youths in community mobilization activities in two Districts of Uganda in 2019
 - Goal 1A: By May 30, 2019, we shall conduct two meager bike competitions in Kasese and Kamuli Districts bringing together over 100 youths each with a theme of; reducing carbon emission for environmental sustainability aimed at making people aware of alternatives of reducing carbon emissions in the atmosphere.
 - Goal 1B: By December 30, 2019, we shall conduct two Football and netball competitions in Kasese and Kamuli Districts targeting at least 300 youths each using IDEAS For Uganda community and School chapters so as more youths are recruited into environmental sustainability movement
- Objective 2: To support the youths in and out of School to plant carbon trees in public and private land by December 2019.

- Goal 2A: By July 30, 2019 we shall have created a network of at least ten tree nursery beds owners in Kasese and Kamuli Districts committed to supplying communities and schools partnering with IDEAS For Uganda, with trees for planting sustainably and on timely basis so as to set a continuous tree planting campaign in the two Districts
- Goal 2B: By October 30, 2019 we shall support the youths in Kasese and Kamuli Districts with 10,000 tree seedlings to plant through Schools and community organized groups(Chapters) so as to keep IDEAS followers more active and impactful on ground
- Objective 3: To empower and engage community and school chapters in timely vigorous clean ups in 2019
 - Goal 3A: By May 30, 2019 we shall have organized at least 20 school and community groups to come up with monthly clean up schedules so as to create demonstration schools and communities with environments free of harmful materials
 - Goal 3B: By September 30, 2019 at least 5 rural schools shall have established gardens fertilized by non degradable materials from clean ups so as to improve their willingness to continuously conduct result oriented clean ups
 - Goal 3C: By December 30, 2019 the 20 organized Schools and Community groups shall have been linked to Government local leaderships for a sustainable conduct of monthly cleanups so as to have the activities owned by local leaders
