Project Introduction:

The Violoncelului urban garden in Bucharest

- **Objective 1:** Organize 3 sessions of planting, permaculture and maintenance
 - **Goal 1A:** Educate the community in gardening related subjects
 - **Goal 1B:** Ensure a proper educational environment for visiting groups of children from the community
- **Objective 2:** Create a corner of pollinator native plants in the garden
 - **Goal 2A:** Educate about the importance of bees and the need to protect them
- **Objective 3:** Maintenance of the 11 fruit trees from the garden
 - **Goal 3A:** Ensure a rich harvest of fruits (pears, apples, nectarines, peaches, apricots, quins)
 - **Goal 3B:** Prepare a series of jams and other winter cans in order to donate them to the members of the community

Project Outcomes:

- A good practice example of an urban garden in the middle of Bucharest
- A non formal education spot in urban gardening for the young generation
- 30 participants at the 3 sessions of planting, permaculture and maintenance
- At least 5 groups of a total of 100 children and youth visiting the garden and learning about urban gardening in 2019
- At least 5000 people reached on our partnering social media channels with educational posts on urban gardening (fb/reciclarecreativa.ro - over 170.000 followers, fb/violonceluluihub - over 1300 followers)
- 100 jars of winter cans made from the fruit trees distributed in the community
